2 Peter 3:9-10 God is all-powerful

Psalm 34:18 God suffers with us and feels our pain

Genesis 6:5-6 God hates evil and injustice

Matthew 9:35-36 Jesus looks for us when we are suffering and has pity on us

I John 4:9-10 God loved us so much he sacrificed his Son for us.

3. What do the scriptures tell us about the origin of suffering in the world?

Sin entered the world when Adam and Eve disobeyed God. Gen 3:1-24, Rom 5:12 Satan rebelled against God and tries to get us to rebel. Lk 22:31, 1Pet 5:8-9, Jn 8:44 God gives us freedom to choose to obey Him or not. Mt 23:37b, Rom 3:10-18 Suffer because of others. I Pet 2:20-22, 3:14-18

Purify our faith I Pet 1:6-7, Jas 1:2-4

Turns evil into good Joseph, Jesus

Comforts us in our suffering so we can comfort others. 2 Cor 1:3-5, Ps 119:50,92

If we are taught that God promises prosperity for everyone who believes

When we do not do things that help our faith grow strong

When the church does not speak out against evil and injustice

II Timothy 4:6-8 poured out as a drink offering...fought the good fight

II Timothy 4:18 the Lord will recue me
